

Context

Panoramic Health was brought in to accelerate enrollment for a Phase III trial targeting CKD patients with obesity. The study previously struggled to meet its enrollment goals, and Panoramic was tasked with delivering rapid enrollment within a compressed timeline.

Objectives

The study evaluated the efficacy of a novel therapy in adults with obesity and CKD in preventing the worsening of kidney function.

- National enrollment goal: 1,000+ patients
- Panoramic enrollment goal: 36 patients across 6 sites
- Target population: Adults with established CKD and obesity, defined by BMI

Process

Panoramic Science streamlines enrollment through a data-driven funnel. EMR queries and chart reviews flag eligible patients who meet the inclusion/exclusion criteria, who are then referred by their treating nephrologist through a defined intake process. Central teams coordinate pre-screens, while rapid scheduling ensures patients move quickly from consent to enrollment.

Because research occurs in the patient's own nephrology clinic with their trusted physician, participation does not cause undue burden on patients.

Impact

By exceeding its assigned enrollment target within a short timeframe, Panoramic Health demonstrated its ability to rapidly identify and enroll targeted patient populations, helping a delayed trial get back on track.

- 45 patients enrolled across 6 Panoramic Health sites
- Exceeded enrollment target by 25%
- Enrollment completed within 10 months, helping accelerate a study that had been behind target
